

Governance

AIM:

The module is designed to enable the learners develop into critical learners in issues of governance both in the theoretical and practical application of skills with the hope of transforming learners to be accountable, transparent, effective, efficient, responsive, tolerant and just in their responsibilities at family, organisation and government levels.

OBJECTIVES:

By the end of the module students should be able to:

1. Define governance and establish and formulate Biblical basis for governance.
2. Critique governance process, mechanisms and policies in their contexts.
3. Formulate and implement sound policies.
4. Examine political leadership with special emphasis on corruption, legitimacy and contemporary demands of leadership and the led. (*they should be able to assess systemic issues of contemporary governance*)
5. Critically evaluate the place of values in the governance process.
6. Critique and formulate approaches to governance based on Biblical values.
